

## What is Turnitin?

- Turnitin is a facility where students submit their coursework to check on similarity report within the service database resources in order to control plagiarism.
  - ❖ **Plagiarism**  
Plagiarism is defined by copying another person's work or ideas as your own without consent and attribute to the original creator.
- In HELP, Turnitin is integrated into HELP LMS where students upload their assignments into **LMS-TII** platform directly for Turnitin to generate the similarity report.

# TURNITIN (LMS-TII)

## Account

- Students register for the subject
- Faculty provides Username and Password for LMS account

## Enroll Class

- Lecturer creates a class and assignment in LMS-TII
- Lecturer provides the **Class ID** and **Class Enrollment Key (Password)** for students to submit an assignment
- Students enroll for the class with the **Class ID** and **Class Enrollment Key** provided by the lecturer

## Submit Paper

- Upload assignment/document in LMS-TII according to class enrolled

## Check Similarity

- Turnitin generates similarity report
- **Result of plagiarism/similarity % (e.g. below 15%)**
