


2. Once the assignment activity screen appears, scroll down to add your submission. Click on “Submit Paper”

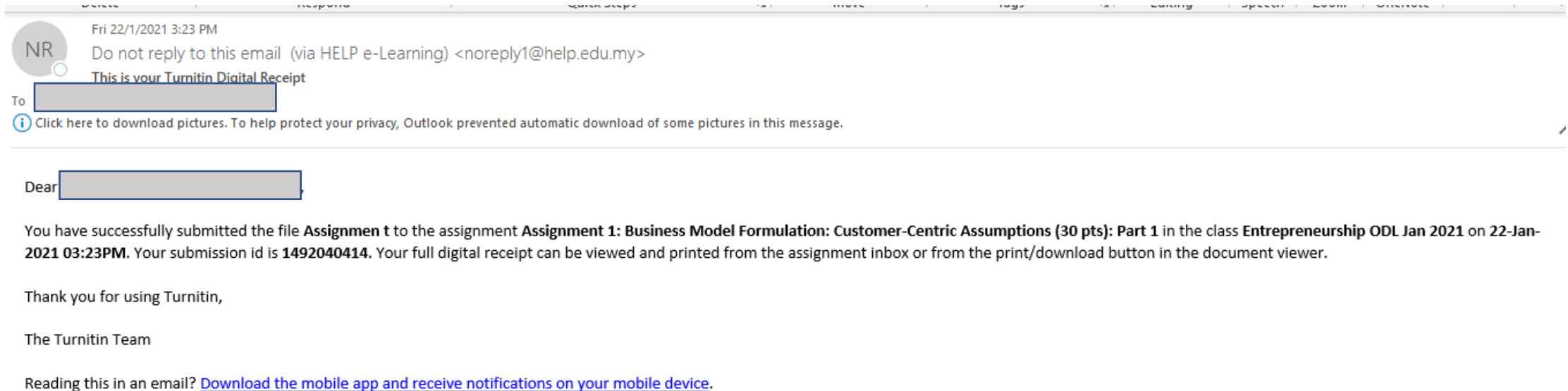
